ABOUT BHUBANESWAR

The Temple City of Odisha

Bhubaneswar is an antiquated city arranged in Khordha region of Odisha, India is the capital city of Odisha and furthermore a standout amongst other spots to encounter Odisha Tourism. Known as 'The City of Temples', Bhubaneswar is one of the antiquated urban communities situated in the eastern piece of India and is a flourishing focus of craftsmanship and culture. Actually, Bhubaneswar implies Lord of the Universe and is known for its engineering and sanctuaries. The source of the city goes back to over 2,000 years while the cutting edge city appeared in 1948. Bhubaneswar was the capital of the Kalinga tradition. Later Emperor Kharavela set up his capital in Sisupalgarh which is on the edges of the city.

Alongside Puri and Konark, Bhubaneswar frames the 'brilliant triangle' of Odisha and is a standout amongst the most went to goals in East India. The city houses in excess of 500 sanctuaries, including the well known sanctuaries like Lingaraj Temple, Mukteswar Temple, Shatrughaneswar Temple, and Parashurameswar Temple. Orisha State Museum, Bindu Sarovara, Nandan Kanan, Dhauli Giri slopes, Ram Mandir, Udayagiri Caves, Khandagiri Caves, and ISCKON Temple are a portion of the best places to visit in Bhubaneswar. Bhubaneswar is well connected to other major cities of India via regular flights and trains.





Lingaraj Temple

Lingaraja Temple is a Hindu temple dedicated to Shiva and is one of the oldest temples in Bhubaneswar, the capital of the Indian state of Odisha, India. The temple is the most prominent landmark of Bhubaneswar city and one of the major tourist attractions of the state.

Mukteswar Temple

Mukteshwara Temple is a 10th-century Hindu temple dedicated to Shiva located in Bhubaneswar, Odisha, India. The temple dates back to 950–975 CE and is a monument of importance in the study of the development of Hindu temples in Odisha.



Udaygiri Caves

Udayagiri and Khandagiri caves, formerly called Kattaka Gumpha or Cuttack caves, are partly natural and partly artificial caves of archaeological, historical and religious importance 3 km south of the city of Bhubaneswar in Odisha, India.

Dhuli Giri Hills

Dhuli Giri Hills, near Bhubaneswar, Odisha, is a significant historical Buddhist site on the Daya River banks, famous for Emperor Ashoka's conversion to Buddhism after the bloody Kalinga War.



Rajarani Temple

The Rajarani Temple in Bhubaneswar, Odisha, is an exquisite 11th-century Hindu temple famous for its stunning architecture, red and yellow sandstone (locally called Rajarani), and intricate erotic carvings of couples, earning it the nickname "Love Temple".

Nandankanan

Nandankanan Zoological Park is a 437-hectare zoo and botanical garden located in Barang village, Odisha, India. It is 10 km to south of Cuttack and 10 km north of Bhubaneswar



Odisha State Tribal Museum

Tribal Research Institute Museum, Museum of Tribal Arts and Artifacts, is a museum in Bhubaneswar, Odisha inside the campus of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes Research & Training Institute. It is popularly known as Tribal Museum and conceptually labeled as Museum of Man.

Ekamra Kanan Botanical Gardens

Ekamra Kanan Botanical Gardens in Bhubaneswar, Odisha, is a sprawling 500-acre, family-friendly botanical park established in 1985. Renowned for its massive cactus garden (over 1,000 varieties), it features a rose garden, a 45-acre lake for boating, a musical fountain, and a children's play area.



Odisha State Museum

The Odisha State Museum, located at Kalpana Square in Bhubaneswar, is a premier institution established in 1932 (relocated in 1960) showcasing the rich cultural and historical heritage of Odisha. It houses extensive, well-organized galleries featuring artifacts, rare manuscripts, sculptures, and natural history items.

Chilika Lake

Chilika Lake in Odisha is home to the world's largest single-location population of endangered Irrawaddy dolphins, numbering around 155 individuals. This shy, elusive species thrives in Chilika's unique brackish water ecosystem, part marine and part freshwater, protected under India's Ramsar Wetlands Convention status

Konark Temple & Chandrabhaga Beach

The Konark Sun Temple, located in Odisha near the Bay of Bengal, is a majestic 13th-century monument dedicated to Surya, the Sun God. Built by King Narasimhadeva I of the Eastern Ganga dynasty, the temple is designed as a colossal stone chariot drawn by seven horses with twelve pairs of intricately carved wheels, symbolizing the passage of time and the cosmic movement of the sun.

Renowned for its exquisite stone carvings, the temple walls depict scenes from daily life, celestial beings, musicians, dancers, animals, and mythological narratives, reflecting the artistic brilliance and advanced craftsmanship of ancient India. The wheels of the chariot also function as sundials, showcasing the scientific knowledge of the era. Although parts of the original structure are now in ruins, the temple remains an architectural marvel and a symbol of India's rich cultural and spiritual heritage. Recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Konark Sun Temple continues to inspire awe for its grandeur, symbolism, and artistic excellence

Puri Jagannath Temple

Puri is a famous coastal city in Odisha, known for the sacred Shri Jagannath Temple, one of the four Char Dham pilgrimage sites in India. Situated along the Bay of Bengal, Puri is also renowned for its golden beaches and vibrant spiritual atmosphere. The city is globally known for the annual Rath Yatra, which attracts millions of devotees. Blending spirituality, culture, and seaside charm, Puri holds a special place in India's religious and cultural landscape.

Satpada

Satpada, located 50 km from Puri on the south-eastern side of Chilika Lake, is the premier destination for spotting the endangered Irrawaddy dolphins (*Orcaella brevirostris*). As a dedicated Dolphin Sanctuary, it offers boat rides where these shy, grey mammals—known for their rounded heads and lack of beaks—are frequently seen surfacing in small groups.
